## Expression of interest to participate on the Limpopo Department of Education (LDOE) and Limpopo Economic Development Agency (LEDA) school sanitation maintenance (pit emptying and cleaning) programme.

**Background:** LEDA is a parastatal of the Limpopo Economic Development Environment and Tourism (LEDET) mandated to provide developmental support to SMMEs and Co-operatives with an endeavour to maximize economic growth and development in the province.

Limpopo Department of Education has entered into an agreement with LEDA to implement the Schools Sanitation Maintenance Programme through the use of Co-operatives in Limpopo Province.

**Eligible co-operatives are therefore requested to express interest in the programme based on the following criteria:**

- Members of the Co-operative must have business experience of at least two years in building maintenance and cleaning services
- Members of the Co-operative must reside within the identified locality (circuit) of interest
- The Co-operative must be compliant with all statutory requirements (e.g. have legal registration documents, valid tax clearance certificate, valid Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment, valid bank account, etc.)
- Co-operatives Members must have basic understanding of Business Management
- Preference will be given to Worker Co-operatives (members being employees)
- At least 01 member should have a valid drivers' licence
- The Co-operative must be registered on the Central Supplier Database (CSD)
- Selected Co-operatives will be expected to enter into a Service Level Agreement with LEDA for a period of 12 months
- All selected Co-operatives must undergo Sanitation Facility Skills Training valued at R2 500.00 payable by appointed Co-operatives.

**Following are the Areas of Operation for the Programme:** CAPRICORN DISTRICT MUNICIPALITY – Polokwane Municipality, Lepelle Nkumpi Municipality, Blouberg Municipality and Aganang Municipality; SEKHUKHUNE DISTRICT MUNICIPALITY – Fetakgomo Municipality, Tubatse Municipality, Makhuduthamakga Municipality, Elias Motswaledi Municipality and Ephraim Mogale Municipality; WATERBERG DISTRICT MUNICIPALITY – Mogalakwena Municipality, Modimolle Municipality, Thabazimbi Municipality and Lephalale Municipality; VHEMBE DISTRICT MUNICIPALITY – Makhado Municipality, Musina Municipality, Thulamela Municipality and Collins Chabane Municipality; MOPANI DISTRICT MUNICIPALITY – Greater Tzaneen Municipality, Greater Giyani Municipality, Greater Letaba Municipality, Ba-Phalaborwa Municipality and Maruleng Municipality.
